

Fairview Farm Boarding Contract

Fairview Farm will provide full care for the horse, which includes: feeding twice daily, stall cleaning, and turnout/turn-in. Hay, shavings, and up to 6 quarts of grain daily is included with board. The boarder will provide his or her own grain for their horse if they do not like what is offered by Fairview Farm. If the horse has any supplements, Fairview Farm will be happy to feed them, but it is the owner's responsibility to supply them. The horse being boarded will follow Fairview Farm's worming schedule. Fairview Farm will buy and give the horse the wormer then will add the wormer to the monthly bill. If you have your own wormer, you can give it to Pam and she will give it to your horse on the same day as all of the others.

The bill must be paid the 1st of the month for that month's board. Any bill that is not received by the 15th of the month will have a \$10 late fee added. If payment is delayed beyond 30 days, a 10% late fee compounded monthly will apply. If the owner neglects to pay the bill in 90 days, Fairview Farm retains the right to sell the horse to get the money needed to pay the bill.

The owner is responsible for all vet and farrier charges. You may use our farrier and vet or use your own.

Horses stabled at Fairview Farm must have both a rabies and negative coggins test from the current year. Copies of both must be received at the farm before the horse is allowed on the premise.

Fairview Farm retains the right to void the contract at any time and can ask the boarder to leave.

If at any time the boarder wishes to leave Fairview Farm, a one month written notice must be given.

The rate for one month's board is \$300 for full care. This includes daily stalling, either during the day or night, depending on the season. The rate for pasture board is \$250. This includes complete turn out with a run in shed. Horses will be stalled during periods of extreme cold or severe weather.
